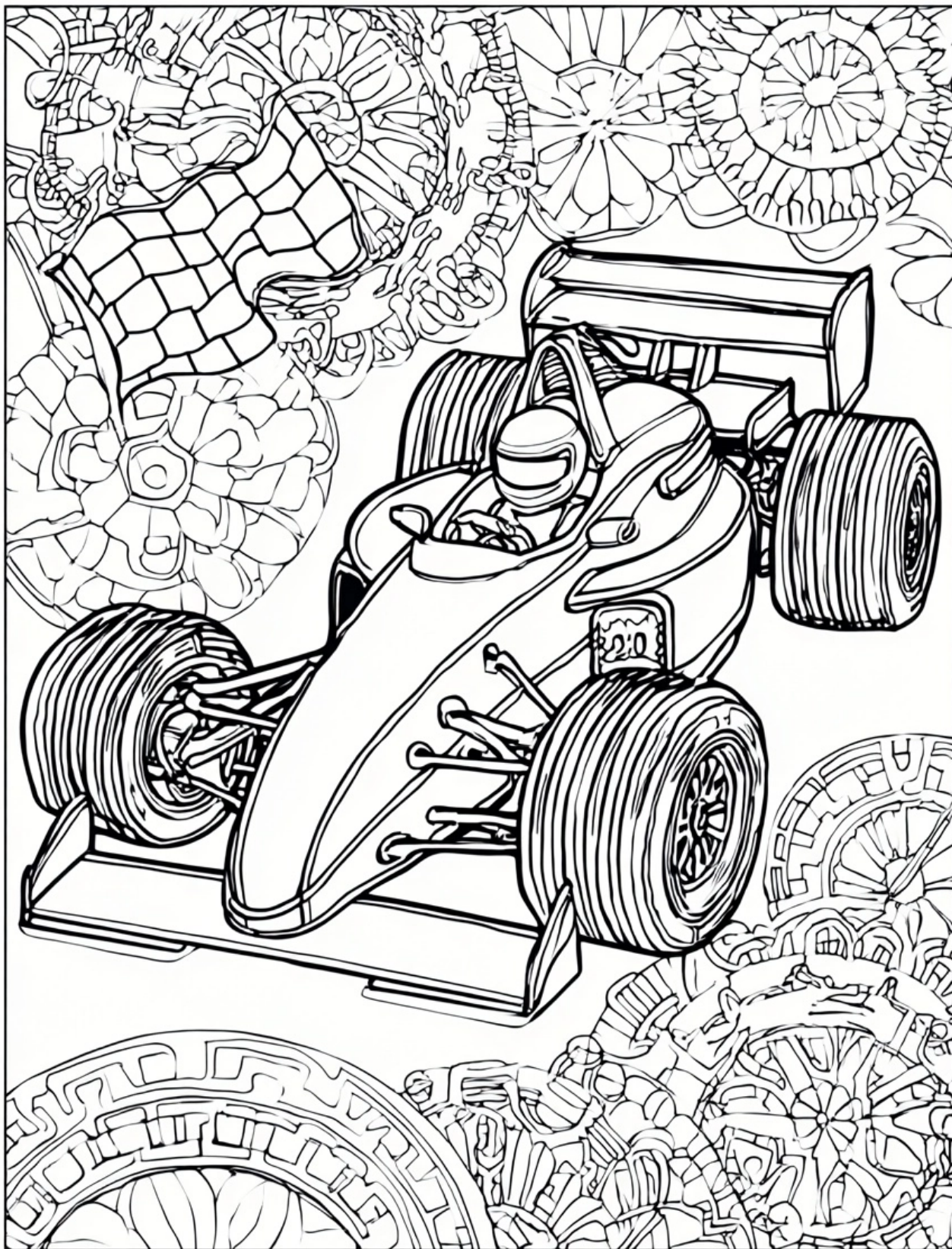




Leontideus rosalia occurs toward falls distal or closer to the initial origin of the canal during rebarbation periods of the continued.

Protoplasts of *Arabidopsis thaliana* were prepared from leaves of 4-week-old plants. The protoplasts were isolated by digestion of the leaves with cellulase and pectinase. The protoplasts were then washed and resuspended in a solution containing 0.5 M sucrose, 0.1 M KCl, 0.1 M MgCl₂, and 0.1 M CaCl₂. The protoplasts were then subjected to a series of centrifugations to remove debris and to concentrate the protoplasts. The final protoplast suspension was then used for the experiments described in this paper.
